The role of the Cell Culture Technician is to perform routine laboratory tasks in support of the operation of the cell culture facility. The role plays an active part in providing support for R&D operations in a multi-disciplinary setting.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for day-to-day operation of the cell culture facility including the maintenance of mammalian cell lines and routine monitoring/cleaning of the facility
- Prepare cells according to specifications for various R&D activities
- Maintain laboratory records according to established SOPs in compliance with QMS
- Contribute knowledge and skills to technical problem solving and product development activities
- Contribute, as required, to laboratory management tasks (e.g. H&S, inventory and purchasing)
- Work in accordance with appropriate regulatory requirements
- Perform such other duties and responsibilities that are consistent with the role of a Laboratory Technician or as may be assigned from time to time
